Protected intersections, also known as Dutch-style intersections or bike roundabouts, are a relatively new design that help guide bicycle traffic safely through an intersection by keeping cars and bikes as separated as possible. Memphis would be one of the first cities in the country to apply this design.

As part of the project, we will undertake an education campaign to teach individuals how to properly use the protected intersections.
